Under the direction of Flavin Judd, artistic director of Judd Foundation, together with Puiforcat artistic directors Charlotte Perelman and Alexis Fabry, the company has produced Judd's designs in sterling silver. The eight-piece service includes distinct yet complementary dinner, bread, soup, salad, and dessert plates, as well as a serving bowl and cups. Configured in various dimensions, the items form a full table setting. Each piece is numbered, and stamped with an artist mark, the luxury brand's emblematic diamond shaped logo containing founder Emile Puiforcat's EP initials.
