The new Silver Set 2025 collection is a creation by British artist Rachel Whiteread. For her first collaboration with a tableware company, Rachel started with a seemingly innocuous material: corrugated cardboard, which she shaped to create a jug, cups, a tray, and napkin rings, thus transforming the material by removing its function. The artisans of the Puiforcat workshop then crafted these creations in sterling silver. The gaze shifts between the two materials, and the object is born: durable, unalterable like silver, yet bearing the trace of fragile cardboard in its grooves and tears. In this translation of the artist's language, the Puiforcat workshop has deployed all its ingenuity and the best of its expertise. Heirs to an exceptional tradition, also skilled in handling the most advanced technologies, such as the digitally controlled milling machine, its artisans have transmuted cardboard into silver, reproducing every detail, every imperfection, every trace of use, in the immutability of the precious metal.
